

HOW IT WORKS

Your pet will learn to associate a scent with a specific meaning. Pets will quickly learn the "stop" and "go" Bkinz™ markers. Most importantly, the mapping program will build confidence for your pet.

The key to success is simplicity. Use the first scent for target items, such as water & food Bowls, beds, crates, and doors to outside.

Scent #2 can delineate pathways throughout your home or office. Scent #3 can be employed to serve as a warning indicator, to be placed near stairs and the edges of coffee tables, etc. Three generous bottles of our proprietary blends of essential oils are provided to develop your own Sight & Scent Mapping Program to teach your pet to discern the different markers. Always be consistent and use the same scents which you began within mapping your home. The Bkinz markers are not presented because it's very important that you assess your own pet's tolerance level. You will be able to determine how much scent your pet needs in order to alert to the Bkinz. Reapply as needed so you can control the program for your dog or cat.

Our crafted scents include blends of Himalayan cedar oil, lemongrass, and spearmint. They are all natural and homeopathic, specifically formulated to be pleasant and distinct yet not greatly noticeable to humans. All our scents are non-irritating to cats and dogs. Absolutely no clove oil is used.

Keep essential oils away from children and pets, store safely.

Tips for safety and success



Remove obstacles areas where your pet needs to go, create safe areas and paths.

Start with one scent at a time, move on to next scent program when your pet gets the hang of it. Training is important, and some pick it up quickly.

Think about your Bkinz™ pathways and destinations before placing markers. It is important to establish a safe area that is cozy, and comfortable, like a retreat zone.

Talk and touch to your pet a lot, he or she no longer can see your face to judge your mood or be assured by your smile.

The Sight Scent™ mapping system was created out of frustration! Our Peggy (14-year old Rough/Border Collie mix) has had greatly decreasing vision and hearing as she ages. We inherited 14-year old Alfie (Papillon/Maltese mix), who is similarly deteriorating. But it wasn't until our beloved Enzo (7-year old black Pug) went totally blind and deaf from SARDS within a few weeks that we really knew we had to do something.

Many of the tools used to assist blind dogs would not work for Enzo because of his contemporaneous deafness. It was heart wrenching to see him sit in the middle of a room with his head hung. Standing motionless for long periods of time with his tail uncurled, a sure sign of unhappiness. Robbed of his hearing and vision in the prime of his life, Enzo came to rely on his sense of smell. The Sight Scent™ system of Bkinz™ was created through much research, trial and error to assist these family members. Our other three dogs who do not have any deficits also approve!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

You know your pet best. Please proceed at a pace that helps them succeed and build confidence. It's important to reach success with your first scent before introducing Scent #2.

Proceed to Scent #3, the "no go" scent only after your pet has learned the first two. Begin mapping with the higher priority target items first:

- Scent #1- Water & food bowls, beds, crates and doors to outside
- Scent #2- Pathways, and ok "to go" areas
- Scent #3- Obstacles, stairs, other "no go" areas

To begin, apply two to three drops of #1 scent to a Bkinz marker pad of your choice, remove the adhesive backing and place on the item at about nose height for the pet. Using your Sight & Scent Mapping Log, record the date, time, scent used, and placement of each marker. Use the logbook for future reference, so you know when you will need to refresh the Bkinz™ markers.

For unusual or odd-shaped applications, please cut a marker to suit your needs. Bkinz does not need to be visible to you to be located by your pet. Also, some furniture may get discolored when placing markers on finished surfaces, So choose locations carefully to avoid damage.

Your Sight Scent™ program works as a constant scent reminder to your pet. The scents themselves have no meaning or value and you must help your pet learn what each scent signifies.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Simply putting up the Bkinz without support from you will be not be very effective. If you might warn your blind pet away from a danger area with a clap of the hand or a sharp word, apply that same training to the Bkinz with scent number three.

Your pet will begin to associate your command to stay away with that scent. Similarly, just as you would guide your blind pet to their bed or water bowl, as you repeatedly do so, he or she will come to associate that scent with target items. The same positive reinforcement applies as you help your pet learn their surroundings with the Bkinz in place. The association will become clear to pets...each at their own speed. They want to be able to navigate their own world with dignity. The Sight Scent™ mapping program affords to them the opportunity to do so.



When your pet demonstrates increased confidence and has learned to locate the target items with Scent #1, introduce Scent #2 as an indicator for pathways in your home or office. You should place the Bkinz markers several feet apart and your pet will learn the pathways that they are denoting. Allow your pet time to absorb the scent programming to achieve confidence. Finally, introduce Scent #3, the HALT scent to mark "no go" areas like table corners, staircases, doorways, or other obstacles. Over time, your pet will become accustomed to areas that are "no go" as well.
